

Supply List For Travel Journal Sketch Class

Materials:

Sketch book: Any type. No bigger than 9x12 and no smaller than 5x7. My favorite is Aquabee Super Deluxe. 9x12. I also recommend a spiral bound pad as they are easier to work in while traveling.

Pens and Pencils: Bring an assortment of writing tools. I like using indelible ink, black or sepia toned pens, that way I can paint over them. I use the Pigma Micron pen size 01. I use mechanical pencils
Bring an assortment of color pencils, any type.

Mat Medium: Any brand. A crappy brush to use with it.

Watercolor Supplies: Bring your standard set up, palette, paints, brushes, water container, tissues, rags and a drawing board. If you don't have a drawing board, a piece of heavy packing cardboard will do. The cardboard should be big enough surface area to work on, approximately 18x20 or bigger.

Reference Materials: Any photos, maps.

Other things to bring if you have them:

- 1) An assortment of decorative papers, rice papers.
- 2) Rubber stamps, especially alphabet stamps. Ink pad.
- 3) Scissors and a hair dryer
